# Don't FALL Victim to Scams: Protect Yourself and Your Money!



Northwest Hills Credit Union representatives will NEVER contact you asking for account numbers, account information, login credentials, or sensitive personal information. While many scam calls come from unknown numbers, scammers can make it appear as though they are calling from legitimate phone numbers. If you are ever unsure if you are speaking with a legitimate Credit Union representative, hang up the phone and contact us directly at (860) 496-7326.

#### **Warning Signs and Red Flags:**

- Your credit score drastically changes, or you receive correspondence about accounts that you did not open. This could be a sign that your identity has been compromised.
- The caller becomes impatient or angry with you if you question them or hesitate to comply with their requests. A legitimate caller will be happy to answer questions, ease your concerns, and give you time to think things over.
- The caller threatens dire consequences if you do not immediately comply with their requests. Scammers create a sense of urgency to shut down critical thinking. If you were actually in trouble, your first contact with government or law enforcement agencies would not be by phone.
- You are instructed to make payments using gift cards or cryptocurrency.

  No government or law enforcement agency accepts gift cards or

  cryptocurrency as payment for taxes, fees, or fines.
- You are instructed to lie to Credit Union staff about the purpose of a large withdrawal or wire transfer. No legitimate organization will ever ask you to lie to your financial institution. Telling the truth allows Credit Union staff to protect your money by spotting potential scams and shutting them down.

## What To Do If Your Information Has Been Compromised:

#### If Your Social Security Number Has Been

**Compromised:** Obtain a copy of your credit report and review it for items you do not recognize. Contact the credit bureaus (Equifax, Experian, & TransUnion) to freeze your credit and dispute any items that are not yours. Contact your financial institutions to let them know that you are a victim of identity theft. Consider putting a password on your accounts for in-person and phone transactions.

#### If Your Account Number Has Been

**Compromised:** Contact the Credit Union immediately to freeze your account and have your funds assigned to a new account number. Don't forget to bring in a list of all outstanding checks and ACH payments so our staff can ensure that your payments will be made from the new account.

#### If Your Credit or Debit Card Number Has

**Been Compromised:** Contact the Credit Union immediately. We will stop your card and order another one for you.

Remember to review your accounts on a regular basis. Contact the Credit
Union immediately to report any unauthorized transactions!
